
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Notes

A custom-made and fitted box makes even a simple gift special. Window sheets can be used for the top, bottom, or filling a cut-out. Dividers can be added.

8 1/2" x 11" card stock can make a 4 1/2" tall box with a 2" x 4 1/2" base, a cube 2 3/4" x 2 3/4" x 2 3/4" or a flat box 7" x 9 1/2" x 3/4". Larger boxes can be made with 12" x 12" card stock. If the box is much bigger, you would need thicker cardboard for it to be sturdy.

1. Measure your gift for the 2 sides (A and B) and height (H). Your card stock will need to be A plus twice the height one way and B plus twice the height the other way. I measured the ramekins which are round, so A and B are both 4". The height is 2 1/4". So the card stock needs to be 8 1/2" x 8 1/2". We will need 2 pieces of card stock the same size.
2. Score the box bottom at the height measurement, so for the ramekins are scored at 2 1/4" on all 4 sides.
3. Create tabs: Snip on the score line and then a little into the tab to create a thin wedge as shown by red triangles in the diagram.
4. Put Sticky Strip on the tab side of the score lines shown by the green.
5. The box top will scored the same way, but you need to move the card stock just about 1/16" away from the Simply Scored. Or you can use a smaller piece and just cover the top inch or two of the box.



Boxes can be decorated in many different ways. I like using Window Sheets, but a border punch around the top is really nice.

6. Use a Framelit to cut a hole in the top center of the box. You may need to fold the sides in so the card stock will fit through the Big Shot.
7. The sides may be cut by the Framelit. If it cuts in a lot, the tabs should be cut so they fold to the uncut side as shown in the diagram.
8. Cut the Candlelight Christmas Window Sheet to fit into the hole, centering the design.
