Notes

- Score the Tip Top Taupe card stock at 4¼", then fold and crease for the card base.
- Stamp the large rose on the Watercolor Paper in VersaMark™ ink. Cover in Clear Stampin' Emboss Powder and return extra to the tub. Heat with the Heat Tool.
- Generously wet the rose with water. Pick up a bit of Watermelon Wonder ink and drip onto the rose. Set aside to dry or speed the process with the Heat Tool.
- Generously wet the leaves with water. Pick up a bit of Mint Macaron ink and drip onto the leaves. Dry as before.
- Stamp the label shape onto the Very Vanilla card stock in Watermelon Wonder ink, then stamp "What a beautiful blessing..." in Tip Top Taupe ink inside the label. Adhere inside the card.
- Stamp "Happy birthday" right above the rose in Tip Top Taupe ink.
- Adhere the watercolor paper to the 5" x 3¾" Watermelon Wonder card stock.
- Punch a hole for the ribbon with the ⅛" Circle punch in the top right. Lace the ribbon through the slot and tie a square knot, pulling only one side. If mailing, do not tie a knot, just adhere the ends behind the card.
- Adhere to the card front with Stampin' Dimensionals.
- Using the Rose Garden Thinlits Dies, cut the rose from Watermelon Wonder and the leaves from Mint Macaron. Snip off extra sections.
- Adhere over the rose with Glue Dots and/or the Fine-Tip Glue Pen.

Lots of ways to color (or not)





Watercolor

This sample uses 2 techniques, watercolor on watercolor paper and cut-outs from card stock.



Sponge color on the cut-out.



Use both the background and the cut-out and place Designer Series Paper® or card stock behind the flowers and leaves. Stamp the leaves on the Designer Series Paper® and cut out on the lines. You don't have to cut out the Watermelon Wonder Designer Series Paper® since it is covered up by the background.



Use colored card stock for the flower and leaves behind the cut-out. Again, stamp the image and cut out.



Use the flowers as puzzle pieces to inset the colors.

The very easiest way to do this:

- Use a dryer sheet when cutting out.
- Remove the frame.
- Rub Press & Seal wrap to hold it together from the front.
- Carefully pull off the dryer sheet.
- Apply Multipurpose Liquid Glue into the frame sections.
- Position the Press & Seal wrap with the pieces over the frame.
- Press the pieces into the glue.
- You could also do this same method with just the puzzle pieces. Just use 2-Way Glue Pen to temporarily glue the "frame"



Use the cut-out as a stencil to sponge on the color, then use the outside over the stenciled image.



Use a monochrome theme. Black and white or black and vanilla look great! Also using gold and silver on a dark background looks very elegant.



Cut out the flower from one color and the leaves from another color and use together. This is the second technique used in the directions.
