Notes

1. Cut 12 strips of paper with Lace Ribbon Border Punch. You can also use plain straight edge strips or a combination of both, alternated. Trim to 6 of the lace patterns or 7". Stack together.
2. Cut 4 leaves with 5-Petal punch from Old Olive.
3. Sponge edges of strips and leaves with Cajun Craze and either of the sponging tools.
4. Apply Shimmer Paint with sponging tool.
5. Cut ¾" circle from More Mustard.
6. With Crop-A-Dile, punch 2 holes in ¾" circle.
7. If using plain strips, punch holes about ¼" from the ends of the strips.
8. Insert brad from the unsponged side at one end of strip. This will leave the "legs" on the bottom. If the brad side is on the bottom, the pumpkin will be unstable.
 - a. If you like, moisten a 1¼" circle of More Mustard in rubbing alcohol and cover the top of the brad, tucking edges under.

9. Lace the twine through the "button" holes. Through the other end of the strips from the unsponged side. Tie a knot. Lace each end through a leaf. Tie another knot. Lace each end through another knot. Tie a knot in each end.
10. Pull the center of each strip apart the ball.
11. You could put a battery-operated votive candle inside.

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
