Notable Notions and Papillon Potpourri


## Notes

1. Flatten a pinch of Simply Pressed Clay. Liberally dust with the Embossing Buddy on both sides. Stamp with the larger round stamp from Notable Notions. Allow to dry overnight.
2. Ink the clay with Tangerine Tango and a Stamping Sponge.
3. Spray the small piece of Very Vanilla with alcohol. Stamp with the text stamp from Notable Notions. Allow to dry.
4. Mix a few drops of Soft Suede ink in the Spritzer with alcohol and spray the Tea Lace Doily. Allow to dry.
5. Fold the Tangerine Tango card stock in half for the card base.
6. Cut $\frac{3}{4}$ " from the long edge of the Very Vanilla card stock.
7. Emboss the larger portion of the Very Vanilla with the Beautifully Baroque folder.
8. Using the brayer, ink with Pistachio Pudding.
9. Cut the narrow portion with the Finishing Touches Edgelits.
10. Stamp the small piece of Very Vanilla (now dry) with the label in Soft Suede.
11. Make a reverse mask of the label. Use it to stamp the butterfly from Papilon Potpourri in Tangerine Tango. Cut out.
12. Cut the small piece of Soft Suede with the label from Chalk Talk Framelits. Punch a hole in one end. Cut off the other end.
13. Stamp the small piece of Tangerine Tango with the butterfly from Papilon Potpourri in Soft Suede. Punch out with the Elegant Butterfly punch.
14. Adhere the Soft Suede strip to the Very Vanilla strip.
15. Adhere the Soft Suede and Very Vanilla strips to the back of the Very Vanilla with Pistachio Pudding.
16. Adhere the dry doily to the card.
17. Adhere the dry Very Vanilla with the butterfly to the Soft Suede label. Tie a knot in the ribbon and pull the ends through the hole in the label. Adhere the whole label to the doily with Stampin' Dimensionals.
18. Stamp the antennae in Soft Suede on the doily.
19. Adhere the butterfly.
20. Adhere the Simply Pressed Clay with Multipurpose Liquid Glue.

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
