Notes

1. Fold the Old Olive card stock in half for the card base.
2. Ink the berry stamp with Old Olive, remove the ink from the berries with a Blender Pen, then ink the berries in Raspberry Ripple with the Stampin' Write Marker. Stamp near the long edge of the Whisper White card stock. Repeat 2 more times.
3. Punch out with the Postage Stamp punch.
4. Punch 3 sheets of sticky notes with this same punch.
5. Punch the other edge of the Whisper White card stock with the scallop Edge Border Punch.
6. Adhere the right and center of the Designer Series Paper to the edge of the front of the card.
7. Place the sticky notes evenly space on the Designer Series Paper. Punch both the Designer Series Paper and Old Olive card stock with the Postage Stamp Punch.
8. Slip the scallop boarder between the layers and adhere.
9. Slip the ribbon behind the scallop border and tie a bow. Adhere behind the knot with a Glue Dot, if desired.
10. Adhere the berry "stamps" with Stampin' Dimensionals by placing them into the holes as if they were puzzle pieces.
11. Stamp the greeting of your choice inside the card with Raspberry Ripple ink. The stamp can be inked with a marker or the stamp pad.
