## Stampin' Up!® Classic Stampin' Pad Storage

For each Classic Stampin' Pad, you will need a piece of card stock 51/4" x 91/4".

If you select Whisper White or Very Vanilla, use the thick versions.

With the long side at the top (landscape), score at  $4\frac{1}{4}$ " and 5".

Turn the short side at the top (portrait), ad score at 3/4" on both sides (or 3/4" & 41/2").

Crease with the Bone Folder

Snip and trim the 3/4" tabs and the long tabs on one end which will become the bottom flaps.



Apply adhesives to the tabs and to the bottom flaps as shown.

Fold the flaps up and adhere the bottom flaps so the straight edge match the fold of the tab.

Fold the top flaps over the bottom flaps.

The process is the same for StāzOn®, Memento, and VersaMark™ pads.

StāzOn® and Memento Pads 41/4" x73/4" Landscape score at 31/2" and 41/4" Portrait score at 3/4" and 3 1/2"

VersaMark Pads

4%" x7%" ( $\frac{1}{16}$ " deeper than the StāzOn®.) Landscape score at  $3\frac{1}{2}$ " and  $4\frac{5}{16}$ " Portrait score at 3/4" and 3 1/2"

## Assembly

Cut a piece of foam core board 4" x 19" for each set of 5 stamp pads. For the entire set, you will need 11 pieces. This was sufficient for my set, as it is stored in a shelving unit.

I arranged my stamp pads with the StāzOn® and Memento Pads on the left and the VersaMark™ pad on the right. This left a gap for me to store my Stampin' Scrub. It does stick out past the stamp pads.

To make a totally finished case.

Cut additional pieces of foam core 4" x 19" piece of foam core for the top.

- (2) 11" X 4 for the sides
- (1)  $19\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $11\frac{1}{4}$ " for the back
- (1)  $19 \frac{3}{4}$ " x  $4 \frac{1}{2}$ " for a finished top.

Adhere the top 4" x 19" piece to the top 5 stamp boxes.

Adhere the side pieces.

Adhere the finished top so your raw edges won't show.
