## Painted Poppies

Notes:

1. Score the Basic Black card stock at $41 / 4 "$. Fold and crease for the card base.
2. Stamp a row of poppies in Memento ink across the bottom of the $51 / 4^{\prime \prime} \times 4$ " Whisper White layer. Color, if you'd like. I used the larger splatter stamp and Poppy Parade ink. Adhere this layer inside the card. You may also prefer stamping just the one tall poppy or a printed cut-out from the Elements set.
3. Adhere the Designer Series Paper to the card front.
4. Stamp the greeting in Memento ink near the short side of the 5 " x $33 / 4$ " Whisper White card stock. I used Happy Birthday, but this card would be great for any of the sentiments in Peaceful Moments. Stamp two poppy flowers and two leaves in Memento ink on the same piece. Cut out with the coordinating dies.
5. Use the lacy edge die to cut the Basic Black strip.
6. Use the larger watercolor wash stamp to stamp in Poppy Parade ink around the flower centers. The colors will overlap. You could just stamp one time for lighter flowers or multiple times randomly for dark flowers.
7. Use the larger speckled stamp to stamp the leaves in Old Olive ink. You could stamp several generations of ink for a more solid look.
8. I stamped the bottom of the greeting with the Old Olive speckles and the sides of the greeting with the Poppy Parade wash.
9. Adhere the label to the bottom right of the card front.
10. Tie a small bow with the ribbon. Adhere to the top of the label.
11. Put adhesive in and area about 2" diameter in the upper left corner. Loop the remaining ribbon around your hand and loosely place over the adhesive.
12. Adhere the black circle element over the ribbon. I didn't have enough of these for my group. Rather than buying more sets, I stamped the circle design from Painted Glass in VersaMark ink and embossed with clear powder. Punch it out with the $21 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ Circle Punch. It gives a very similar look.
13. Adhere the flowers and leaves on the circle with Stampin' Dimensionals. You could use a flower element instead of stamping the flowers and leaves.
