Notes:

1. Fold a notecard.
2. Stamp the daisy in Basic Gray ink on the bottom left of the card front
3. Stamp the greeting in Basic Gray ink to the right of the flower.
4. Clean the stamps and the block.
5. Press the Daffodil Delight ink on one corner of the Clear Block. Use the Blender Pen to pick up some ink and color in the flower. Clean the Blender Pen by scribbling on scratch paper until no color is left.
6. Press the Granny Apple Green ink on another corner. Use the Blender Pen to pick up some ink and color the stem and leaves.

Step It Up with Layers ★

1. Stamp Happy Birthday in Basic Gray ink all the way to the right of the card front.
2. Instead of stamping the flower on the card front, stamp it on a piece of Whisper White or an extra card cut to 1 ¾" x 3". Color as before.
3. Cut a piece of Daffodil Delight card stock to 2" x 3 ¼". Adhere the stamped flower to the Daffodil Delight piece.
4. Adhere both to the card front with Stampin' Dimensionals.

Step It with a Punch & Ribbon ★

1. Press the Daffodil Delight ink to about 9" of the Crinkled Seam Binding. Set it aside to dry.
2. Ink just the flower in Basic Gray ink and stamp on the card front. Repeat, stamping the flowers close together. Color in the flowers with Daffodil Delight ink and a Blender Pen.
3. Stamp the flower in Basic Gray ink on another piece of Whisper White card stock or an extra card. Stamp the greeting in Basic Gray ink right next to the stem. Color the flower and stem. Punch out with the 2 ¼" Circle Punch.
4. Adhere the flower circle to the card front with Stampin' Dimensionals.
5. Use a tissue to wipe off any extra ink from the ribbon. Tie it in a bow. Adhere to the card front with a Mini Glue Dot.

Or you can cut it like I did in this video.

You get 2 sheets with each color.

Score 1 sheet the long way at 4 1/4". Rotate 90° and cut at 5 1/2" for 2 card bases.

Cut the other sheet at 5 1/4" (5 1/4" x 8 1/2") Rotate 90° and cut two pieces at 4" for 2 large (5 1/4" x 4") layers.

Cut the other half to 5 1/2" (5 1/2" x 8 1/2"). Cut at 2 3/4". Rotate 90° and cut at 4 1/4" for 4 small (2 3/4" x 4 1/4") layers
