Notes:

I used a lot of Stampin' Dimensionals in layers on this card. I love the way the layers look, but it would require extra postage. You could modify this by just using Stampin' Dimensionals to raise one layer.

- Score the Cinnamon Cider card stock at 4 ¼". Fold and crease for the card base.
- Cut one long side of the 5 ½" x 4" Bumblebee card stock with the open floral border. This die cuts on one side. There are extending pieces that are closer to the side that cuts. The outermost leaves just barely fit on a 5 ½" card so take care when placing the die on the card stock.
- Place the Bumblebee card stock in the Tasteful Textile 3D Embossing Folder with the die cut edge outside of the folder. Emboss in the Stampin' Cut & Emboss Machine. (I had areas on this folder that didn't emboss well with my Big Shot. It wasn't bad, but not perfect. If you have the same trouble, try using the new platforms that are made for the Stampin' Cut & Emboss Machine.
- Lay the ribbon over the Bumblebee card stock next to the edge of the embossing. Adhere the ends behind the layer and adhere the layer to the card front.
- Stamp the large sunflower in Cinnamon Cider ink on each of the 4" x 4" squares of Bumblebee card stock. Cut one with the outline die and one with the detailed die. Stamp just the flower center on the 1" x 1" Cinnamon Cider piece. Cut this out with the flower center die. Curl the edges of the flower center under just a bit.
- Adhere the detailed flower to the solid flower with Stampin' Dimensionals under the center. Adhere the flower center with a double layer of Stampin' Dimensionals.
- Stamp the same flower in Cinnamon Cider on the Very Vanilla layer so about a third of the flower is on the card stock. You can also stamp the envelope.
- Stamp the large leaf three times in Old Olive ink on the Old Olive card stock. Cut the leaves with the coordinating die as well as two each of the delicate stem dies.
- Stamp the sentiment in Cinnamon Cider ink centered on the Very Vanilla strip. Cut the ends with the Lovely Labels Pick a Punch. Cut the ends of the Cinnamon Cider strip as well. Adhere the Very Vanilla to the Cinnamon Cider. Add Cinnamon Cider enamel dots on the ends. Adhere this to the card front near the bottom.
- Adhere the delicate stems so they face out from the ender of the card to just the top of the greeting strip.
- Adhere the sunflower to center of the card front with Stampin' Dimensionals.
- Adhere the three leaves, tucking them under the flower. Two of my leaves go out toward the top corners of the card and the third is between the delicate leaves and to the left of center.



I actually cropped off the top of this photo, but I think you can see the difference on the left image between the middle and bottom.
