Beautiful Friendship Pop Up Card

*20-21 = Annual Catalog, AD Mini = August-December Mini Catalog, JJ Mini = Jan-June Mini Catalog
$\mathrm{BB}=$ Beginner Brochure, $\mathrm{SAB}=$ Sale-a-Bration Brochure (Level 1 is free for $\$ 50$ purchased products)
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Notes:

1. Score the $5 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime} \times 8 \frac{1}{2}$ " Rococo Rose card stock at $41 / 4$ ". Fold and crease for the card base.
2. Score the $1 \frac{1}{4}$ " $\times 31 / 2$ " Basic White strip at $3 / 4 ", 21 / 2 "$, and 3." Fold and crease. *See note below.
3. Stamp the roses in Rich Razzleberry ink on the $4 " \times 21 / 2 "$ Basic White card stock. Cut with the \#5 Hippo \& Friends Die. Use the Multipurpose Liquid Glue to highlight the rose petals. Allow to dry.
4. Cut the Rich Razzleberry card stock with the \#4 and \#5 Hippo \& Friends Dies, creating a frame. I suggest you use Tape to keep the two die pieces in the right place.
5. Use the \#5 Die in the middle of the $51 / 4 " \times 4 "$ Rococo Rose card stock. Place on the card front and lightly mark the opening. Emboss the layer with the Painted Texture 3D Embossing Folder.
6. Cut the card front where marked with the \#5 Hippo \& Friends Die.
7. Using the large fern and the double ended leaves, cut 2 sets from the Pear Pizzazz card stock. We'll actually only use the five tips of the fern pieces. Trim away the bottom two
8. Adhere the embossed layer to the card front, carefully aligning the openings.
9. Adhere the Rich Razzleberry frame to the card front, again aligning the openings.
10. Stamp Birthdays are the best days in Rich Razzleberry ink at the bottom center of the $51 / 4$ " $\times 4$ " Basic White layer. Adhere to the card inside.
11. Add Stampin' Seal+ to the two end sections of the Basic White strip. Fold the strip at the $21 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ mark. Place with the $3 / 4$ " end just below the fold of the card inside, adhesive side up and close the card.
12. With the stamped flowers on a piece of scratch paper, put some of the Gilded Leafing over the dried Multipurpose Liquid Glue. Brush to cover all the glue and remove the extra gilding. Return the extra to the tub
13. Place Stampin' Seal+ on the Basic White strip, keeping away from the top $1 / 4$ ". Place the ferns on the strip so they fan away and toward the sides without going past the outer edges. Add the double ended piece at the fold (at $21 / 2$ ")
14. Close the card. Place the stamped flowers in the opening, adhering to the strip inside.
15. Add the remaining double ended leaf piece to the bottom center of the opening Add 3 gold pearls to the center.

I liked that the pop-up presents the piece at a slope. But that results in the card not opening flat. If you prefer it to open flat, use a $1 \frac{1}{4 \prime \prime} \times 33 / 4$ " strip. Score at $3 / 4 \prime, 21 / 2^{\prime \prime}$, and $31 / 4$ ".
