## Notes

This is another quick card that is useful for many occasions. You could do this same card with any subtly printed Designer Series Paper and any larger image in any color scheme.

1. Score the Crumb Cake card stock at $41 / 4$. Fold and crease for the card base.
2. I chose a piece of very subtle text from the World of Good Specialty Designer Series Paper.
3. Stamp the deer in Early Espresso ink on the Designer Series Paper. I stamped it about an inch away from the bottom left corner.
4. Color the ground with the White Stampin' Chalk Marker.
5. Adhere the Designer Series Paper to the $51 /{ }^{\prime \prime \prime} \times 4$ " Early Espresso layer
6. Wrap 5" of the ribbon across the card, about 1 " from the top. Tie the remaining 3 " in a knot. You can slide it to where you want it and it looks great every time. I slid the knot to about 1" from the left side
7. Ink the whole Many Messages stamp with VersaMark ink and stamp the $51 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 7^{\prime \prime}$ Early Espresso card stock. Dust with the White Stampin' Emboss® Powder. Heat with the Heat Tool. Cut with the Messages Die.
a. One stamp, one die, and you have 23 greetings, ready and waiting
b. Keep the framework and you can use it to stamp just one tag at a time.
c. Keep several sets of blank labels in Basic White, Very Vanilla, and maybe Crumb Cake.
d. Stamp and Emboss with White Stampin' Emboss Powder on Early Espresso, Basic Black, and Night of Navy.
e. Layer these tags with tags from Ornate Frames, Stitched So Sweetly, or punches for even more pizzazz.
8. Pick a greeting of your choice and adhere either over the ribbon, as I did, or perhaps toward the bottom right corner.
