Notes:

The measurements with red asterisks are approximate. I cut around the images I wanted.

- 1. Score the 3 ½" x 4" Designer Series Paper at ½", 1 ¾", 2 ½", and 3 ½". Fold and crease for the center tower. Adhere the ½" flap.
- 2. Adhere each of the 45%" x 37%" Balmy Blue layers to the tower with the left side of the card stock at the left crease of the Designer Series Paper. This makes the card base. Everything else is just decoration. I liked having a 5%" strip of decorations on the right side of each set of panels, but that's not necessary.

First set of panels

This is actually the last set of panels where you will sign the card, but I think it will make more sense to start here.

- 3. Cut the 35%" x 35%" square of Designer Series Paper from the top left corner to the bottom right corner. Adhere just the very edges to the left panel, leaving the diagonal edge open. This will make a pocket for a note, cash, or gift card.
- 4. Stamp one end of the 3" x 2" Basic White piece with the accessories you want. I stamped the shopping bag in Calypso Coral ink and the scarf in Misty Moonlight ink, but you could stamp these in any of the colors or stamp the balloon, fishing pole, tree, or present. Stamp the penguin on the other end of this piece. The bottom of the penguin should be toward the top of the card stock so it fits in the punch easily. Stamp the beak in Calypso Coral ink. Punch out. Adhere the bottom of the penguin to the triangle. The head can go above the pocket.
- 5. Stamp the snowflakes in Balmy Blue ink on the right inch or so of the 4 3/8" x 3 5/8" Basic White piece. Adhere to the right panel.

Second set of panels

This is actually the "front" of the card.

6. Adhere the 3 ½" x 3 5/8" green trees to the left panel.

^{***} To be honest, I swapped out an overhead transparency sheet for the Window Sheet. The Window Sheet will work but was a bit too stiff for what I wanted.

- 7. Adhere the 3 ½" x 3 ½" Soft Sea Foam to the right panel, ½" from the center.
- 8. *1 Fussy Cut a big sitting bear and adhere to the Soft Sea Foam.
- 9. Punch a penguin from the same piece with the Penguin Builder Punch. Adhere to the left panel.
- 10. Stamp *To the coolest friend ever* in Tuxedo Black ink on the 3 ½" x ½" Basic White strip. Stamp the snowflakes in Balmy Blue ink on the ends. Adhere over the Soft Sea Foam layer.
- 11. Tie a small bow around the organdy ribbon. Adhere to the right side of this panel.

Third set of panels

- 12. Stamp the curvy line in Balmy Blue ink on one 3 ½" x 3 5%" Basic White layer. The line should go from about 1" from the top left corner to about 1¼" down from the top right corner.
- 13. Stamp the front facing penguin in Tuxedo Black ink toward the bottom left corner. Stamp the beak in Calypso Coral ink just below the black in the center of its face. Stamp the antlers in Cinnamon Cider ink on its head. Punch out a penguin from scrap paper. Set it over the penguin. Stamp just the toes in Calypso Coral ink. Remove the paper scrap. Stamp a couple of trees in Soft Sea Foam ink. Adhere to the left panel.
- 14. Continue the "hill" from 1 ¼" down from the top left corner of the second 3½" x 3 5%" Basic White layer. Stamp the sledding penguin in the middle of the hill. Stamp the sideways beak in Calypso Coral ink. Stamp the knit cap on its head. I used Misty Moonlight, but you could use any of the ink colors. Stamp a couple more trees. Adhere to the right panel. Adhere the 5%" x 3 5%" green trees strip to the right side of the panels.

Fourth set of panels

- 15. Adhere the two 35%" x 35%" Designer Series Paper pieces to the next set of panels. These are a bit wider. I put these pieces right next to the center fold.
- 16. *2 Cut out a large standing bear. We will be putting the bear on a pop-up strip. Decide how high up you want the bear. The strip should be behind its belly.
- 17. Score the ***Window sheet at ½". Score the 2" x ½" Basic White strip at ½" and 1". We're combining these two pieces to make the pop-up. I wanted the Window Sheet so it didn't show as much as the Basic White. But the Window Sheet wasn't bendy enough to make the mechanism work easily.
- 18. Crease the ½" score line well. Adhere the ½" section with the end at the center of the card. Fold it back toward the right panel. Adhere with Tear & Tape Adhesive.
- 19. Crease the Basic White strip on the score lines. Fold the first score line and open the second flat. Overlap this strip over the Window Sheet strip and adhere with Tear & Tape Adhesive. Adhere the folded ½" section to the right panel. Add a 1" strip of Tear & Tape Adhesive to the Basic

- White strip starting from the second score line toward left side. Remove the backing and adhere to bear.
- 20. Add the striped \%" x 3 \%" strip to the right side of the panel.
