Notes:

1. Cut the Basic White card stock in half, 5 ½" x 8 ½". Score the card stock at 4 ¼". Fold and crease for the card base.
2. Stamp the door scene in Tuxedo Black ink on the front of the card, a bit lower than center.
3. Stamp the potted tulips on the inside of the card in the lower left.
4. Color the images with Watercolor Pencils. I used Real Red for the door and bicycle, Old Olive for the leaves, Pacific Point for the pots, Daffodil Delight for the flowers, and Early Espresso for the deck and baskets. I colored the bricks lightly with Rich Razzleberry for my original. I may try a different color next time.

Our Watercolor Pencils can be activated with liquid. Try using a Blender Pen over each color. Clean the pen before switching to another color. They're easy to clean by scribbling on scratch paper until it doesn't leave a color.
