Notes:

- 1. When I cut card stock for a card base, I usually score it in half one way and then cut in half the other. This gives me two card bases. If I don't do that, I'll cut the card stock in half, then score one piece in half. I'll cut the other
- 2. have into one 4" x 5 $\frac{1}{4}$ " piece and two 4 $\frac{1}{4}$ " x 2 $\frac{3}{4}$ " pieces.
 - a. You can start with the long way or the short way for different card bases.
- 3. Fold the front of the card base.
 - a. The fold should be at least an inch from the edge. If it's more than half the width of the card the edge will go past $5 \frac{1}{2}$ ".
 - b. A fold parallel to the center crease is easiest. If you cut at a diagonal, you will have corners that extend beyond the card front. Cut the corners off so the card will still fit in an envelope.
 - c. You can fold the front up or down for totally different looks.
 - d. Your initial fold does not need to be in the middle. You can have the center of the card be straight with folds on either side. This one
 - e. might require a little math to figure out where your first folds should be. You'll probably want the finished card to still measure 4 $\frac{1}{4}$ " x 5 $\frac{1}{2}$ ".
- 4. Cut the Designer Series Paper at the same place as your fold. I wanted a piece of Designer Series Paper to show on the inside. I also used a piece on the portion folded back. If you folded at an angle, you'll need to trim off those same corners.
- 5. Or cut a portion of the front layer. If you do this, you'll want to include the inside edge it your design of the front.
