Notes:

- Score the Cinnamon Cider card stock at 4 ¼". Fold and crease for the card base.
- Stamp the right facing bee in Tuxedo Black Memento ink at the upper left corner of one of the 5¼" x 4" Thick Basic White pieces. Color the bee with the Daffodil Delight Stampin' Blends™ marker. Color the wings with Wink of Stella® Clear Glitter Brush. Adhere one of the green Designer Series Paper strips near the bottom. Adhere to the inside of the card.
- Emboss another Basic White layer with the Hive 3D Embossing Folder. Very lightly brush Cinnamon Cider ink across the embossing with a Sponge Dauber.
- Lay a Cinnamon Cider Designer Series Paper strip vertically ½" from the left side of the card. Adhere the ends to the back. Repeat with the other 2 Cinnamon Cider strips, leaving about ⅛" between the strips. Weave the 3 remaining green Designer Series Paper strips through the Cinnamon Cider strips, adhering to the back. You may want to add a bit of adhesive to keep the strips on the embossed layer. I suggest Multipurpose Liquid Glue or Mini Glue Dots. Adhere this layer to the card front.
 - If you find it difficult to weave and/or to tuck the ends under the card, try this alternative.
 - Adhere two Cinnamon Cider strips vertically about ½" apart on the embossed layer.
 - Adhere two Garden Green strips horizontally about ½" apart on the embossed layer.
 - Adhere one Cinnamon Cider strip between the first two.
 - Adhere one Garden Green strip between the first two.
 - Trim the ends at the edge of the embossed layer.
- Stamp the tall flower in Garden Green ink, the left-facing bee in Tuxedo Black Memento ink, and the greeting *Stay wonderful* or another greeting in Cinnamon Cider ink. If you are in my workshop, I've pre-cut the pieces and arranged the stamps on a Stamparatus. You can ink the stamps separately with Stampin' Spots.
- Color the flowers with Stampin' Blends™. There is no Garden Green Stampin' Blends™, so I used the Watercolor Pencil. Color this bee with the Daffodil Delight Stampin' Blends™ and Wink of Stella® Clear Glitter Brush. You could decide to color the flowers with the Crushed Curry Watercolor Pencil instead of the Stampin' Blends™.
- Cut the flowers and bee with the coordinating Honeybee Blooms Dies. Cut the greeting with the #2 hexagon from the Beautiful Shapes Dies.
- Cut the Garden Green card stock with the grass die. Cut the Cinnamon Cider card stock with the #1 hexagon and the thin flower die. They will just barely fit. Place the hexagon with the flat edge next to the short edge of the card stock. Lay the flower diagonally in the remaining space. (or use a larger piece of card stock.)

9. Adhere the stamped hexagon to the Cinnamon Cider one. Adhere them near the middle of the card with Stampin' Dimensionals.
10. Add Square Gems where the Designer Series Paper strips cross. I put Cinnamon Cider ones on the green strips and Bumblebee ones on the Cinnamon Cider strips. You will not need gems in the center, the top center, or the upper right corner.
11. Adhere the Garden Green and Cinnamon Cider die-cuts over the weaving and the hexagon.
12. Adhere the flowers and bee with Mini Stampin' Dimensionals.
