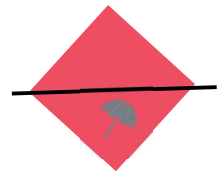

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Notes:

I usually design my cards on my own. Sometimes I find a layout I like and use it with different stamps and colors. This card was CASE'd from Dawn Griffith who CASE'd the layout from a card by Ascencion Guzman. I changed Dawn's card a bit. I changed the colors and the Designer Series Paper. I also changed the ballerina to a tight rope walker.

I changed the sizes of the panels so that the white inside layer doesn't show when the card is closed. I also wanted the hippo to be more upright. I made the top section narrower to give more room to write. The bottom panel is quite a bit larger. You could certainly stamp a greeting on scrap Basic White card stock and either punch it out or cut it out to add to the large bottom panel.

- Score the Sweet Sorbet card stock at 5 1/2", 6 1/2", and 8 7/8". Fold and crease for the card base.
- Measure the center of the end with the smallest section. This is at 2 1/8". Cut a diagonal point from the creases to the center mark.
- Stamp the hippo wearing the tutu in StāzOn® ink in the center of the 2 3/4" square Basic White piece.
- Paint the hippo. Paint the hippo with clear water, avoiding the eyes, nails, tutu, and shoes. Scribble some Orchid Oasis ink on a clear block. Pick up a tiny bit of the ink and color the hippo. Allow to dry. Meanwhile...
- Layer the Designer Series Paper onto the Basic White pieces and adhere them to the card.
 - 4" x 3/4" Designer Series Paper on the 4 1/8" x 7/8" Basic White and goes on the top section.
 - 4" x 2 1/8" Designer Series Paper on the 4 1/8" x 2 1/4" Basic White and goes on the middle section.
 - 4" x 2" Designer Series Paper on the 4 1/8" x 2 1/8" Basic White. This one goes on the inside bottom. Adhere with Stampin' Dimensionals.
- Using the bow maker, tie a bow. I left one hole between the pegs so the bow is nearly 2". Wrap the ribbon around the pegs and cross the ends in front. The end that is on top should go down between the pegs, up and over the ribbon. Before you tie the knot, add the 4" piece and knot the ends, including the 4" piece in the knot. Place the bow in the center of the top panel. Wrap the ends to the inside and adhere. Adhere the top panel down over the ribbon.
- Adhere the remaining 4 1/8" x 2 1/8" to the card inside.
- If you desire, cut out an umbrella from the Glimmer Paper. Keep the umbrella at least 1/4" from the edges and within half of piece.
- Open the card. Adhere the Glimmer Paper to the triangle with the umbrella-shaped hole toward the point. Do not use any adhesive beyond the triangle! Fold back the triangle so the Glimmer Paper faces out.



10. The painted hippo should be dry. Scribble the block with the Sweet Sorbet marker. Squeeze out some water from the Water Painter and pick up a bit of the ink. Paint the tutu, nails, and shoes.
11. With a ruler and the black marker, draw a line from the side corners to the tip of the hippo's toe to make the tightrope.

12. Adhere this panel to the Glimmer Paper. It should cover the umbrella-shaped hole.
13. Add the umbrella so it looks like the hippo is holding it.
