Notes:

4 sheets of this **Designer Series Paper** would be perfect for this card, 2 sheets of each. 6 cards per sheet. 48 cards per pack.

I only used 7" for the ribbon, so you only need one roll for 48 cards.

\$53.50 for the consumable products for 48 cards, \$1.12 each.

- 1. Score **24 full sheets** of card stock at 2 ¾" and 5 ½". Turn and cut 2 sheets at a time at 4 ¼". Fold in half and then fold the right panel up and to the left. If you look at the bottom of the card, it will form a Z. Crease for 48 card bases.
- Cut 12 full sheets of Evening Evergreen card stock to 5 ¼" x 4" for 48 large layers.
- 3. Cut 4 sheets of the Designer Series Paper to 3 ¾" x 12" strips. You should be able to cut all 4 sheets at once. Turn and cut to 5". This should give you 48 5" x 3¾" pieces.
- 4. Use the Rectangular Postage Stamp Punch to punch 48 pieces from Basic White card stock. You should be able to get at least 20 from one sheet of Basic White card stock, so you'll need 2 sheets plus 8 from a third sheet.
- 5. From each of the 48 pieces of Evening Evergreen, punch 2 of the Postage Stamps from one end. Be sure to leave at least a ½" border. This gives you 96 pieces, as you'll need 2 for each card. You'll need 5 sheets.



- 6. Stamp Merry Christmas in Evening Evergreen ink on each of the white Postage stamp pieces. Glue an Evening Evergreen piece so it shows just a bit lower and to the right of the Basic White piece. Glue a second Evening Evergreen piece so it shows just a bit higher and to the left of the white piece.
- 7. Adhere the Designer Series Paper to the Evening Evergreen piece.
- 8. Tie a knot about 3" from the end of the ribbon. Do not pull it tight so that the knot remains a full knot. Cut the ribbon to 5". Repeat for 48 pieces of ribbon, each with a knot in the middle.
- 9. Wrap each piece of ribbon around the end of the Designer Series Paper/Evening Evergreen layer on the end with the holes.
- 10. Adhere just the left side (with the holes) to the small flap on the card front. The holes should not show.
- 11. Adhere the greeting tag at an angle with the corner right under the knot.
