Prepare

- Mark the card base in the color of your choice as shown and score on the dashed lines.
- Fold and crease. Green lines are "Mountain Folds". Red lines are "Valley Folds."
- 3. Firmly crease all the folds.
- 4. Adhere the Adhesive Sheet to the Distressed Gold Specialty Paper.
- 5. Cut the Designer Series Paper as shown, keeping all three sections.
- 6. Using a Bow Maker, wrap the Gray Granite Baker's Twine around the pegs two times and tie the bow as usual.

Stamp

- 7. Stamp Wishing you the best birthday ever in Basic Gray ink on you color of card stock on the right end of the 4 1/4" x 1 1/2" card stock.
- 8. Stamp the leaf, shell, or flower with your color on the other end of the 4 ¼" x 1 ½" card stock.


9. Cut and Punch

- 10. Cut out the leaf, shell, or flower and the background from the Distressed Gold Specialty Paper with the dies.
- 11. Punch the greeting with the Rectangular Postage Stamp Punch.

Assemble

- 12. Adhere the Basic White card stock to the inside of the card.
- 13. Adhere the right triangles (the two outside triangles) with the gold side up on the bottom corners of the white card stock.
- 14. Adhere the remaining Designer Series Paper triangle to the center triangle of the card front.
- 15. Adhere the folded sections of the card front, making sure there won't be adhesive showing.
- 16. Remove the backing from the background Distressed Gold piece over the center triangle.
- 17. Adhere the greeting with Stampin' Dimensionals.
- 18. Adhere the flower, shell, or leaf over the greeting piece.
- 19. Adhere the leaf, shell, or flower highlights over the card stock.
- 20. Add the bow with Mini Glue Dots.

Optional: stamp the flower, shell, or leaf outline on the white card stock inside the card and on the envelope.
