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Notes:

Prepare

- Print the calendar page, setting your printer to print on 2 sides and to flip on the short edge.
 - If your printer does not print on both sides, print the page with December/January, watching which direction the paper comes out of your printer. Mine comes out top first with the printing facing up. I want to feed the paper in again with the blank side up and the bottom of the page entering the printer first. Rotate the paper around and flip it over.
 - Page 2: October/March with April/September upside down on the back.
 - Page 3: August/May with June/July upside down on the back.
- Cut out the calendar. The borders are shown on the pages for December and January and every other page.

Cut & Emboss

- Emboss the 3" x 6" Soft Succulent card stock in the Cane Weave embossing folder.
- Cut the Soft Succulent Fine Shimmer paper with the #6 Something Fancy Die.
- Cut the Soft Succulent card stock with the #7 Something Fancy Die.
- Cut the digits 2023 (you'll have to use the 2 twice) from the Soft Succulent Fine Shimmer paper. I used the Adhesive Sheet, but you could use Multipurpose Liquid Glue if you prefer.

Stamp & Color

- Stamp the large leaf outline stamp in Soft Succulent ink on the Basic White card stock. Ink the solid large leaf image with the same ink but stamp off on scrap paper for a lighter color. Stamp over the outline.
- Stamp the large flowers in Sweet Sorbet ink, fitting it into the spaces between the leaves. Ink the solid large flower image with the same ink but stamp off on scrap paper for a lighter color. Stamp over the outline.
- Stamp the large flowers a second time with both the outline and the solid fill, but not with the leaves.
- Stamp the single large leaf and the tiny leaf cluster in Soft Succulent ink. Stamp the coordinating solid images, stamping off as above.
- Fussy cut the leaf and flowers and the tiny leaves. Punch the small flower and the single leaf.

Assemble

- Place the calendar PDF centered on the Sweet Sorbet card stock. Be sure that the pages are in order.
 - Top Sheet: December/January with February/November upside down on the back.
 - Page 2: October/March with April/September upside down on the back.
 - Page 3: August/May with June/July upside down on the back.

13. Staple the card stock and calendar pages at 3 ¼", making sure you are stapling between months.
14. Adhere the embossed Soft Succulent layer to the front cover.
15. Adhere the cut-out of the flowers on the left side.

16. Adhere the Soft Succulent card stock label over the Soft Succulent Fine Shimmer Paper. Adhere the numbers for the year on the Soft Succulent layer. They will extend past the edges. Adhere this to the calendar front on the lower right side.

17. Adhere the single leaf, the tiny leaf cluster, and the small flower, overlapping the labels.

I did not use Stampin' Dimensionals or embellishments so that the calendar will be flat. This is especially important if you keep the calendar in the clear checkbook cover and carry it in your purse throughout the year. If you are keeping it on your desk, you could certainly add more thickness and embellishments.
