Notes:

- Score the 10½" x 4" Basic Black card stock at 5¼". Fold and crease for the card base.
- Score the 2¾" x 2¾" Fresh Freesia card stock diagonally (corner to corner).
- Cut the Delightfully Eclectic Designer Series Paper at a diagonal.
- Cut the Window Sheet with the Dots & Spots Die.
- Stamp the 3¾" x 2" Basic Black card stock with the Countryside Corners stamp and White Craft Ink. Allow to dry, then cut with the #4 Countryside Corners die.
- Cut the 3¼" x 1½" Basic White card stock with the #5 die.
- Stamp the floral stamp in Fresh Freesia ink on the bottom left corner of one 5" x 3¾" Basic White card stock and on the left side of the piece cut in step 6.
- Stamp *Life is better when you're crafting* in Tuxedo Black Memento ink over the floral image in step 6.
- Lay the Window Sheet that was cut with the Dots & Spots die over the other 5" x 3¾" Basic White card stock. Try to hold it still. Use a Blending Brush to brush Fresh Freesia ink into the holes and onto the Basic White card stock.
- Adhere the Basic White layer with the stamped flowers on the inside of the Basic Black card base.
- Adhere the triangle of Designer Series Paper on one side of the 2¾" x 2¾" Fresh Freesia square.
- Place Multipurpose Liquid Glue on the inside of the 2¾" x 2¾" Fresh Freesia square that does not have the Designer Series Paper. Lay the open edge of the card base on the glue. Close the triangle to make sure there is enough space for the folds.
- Adhere the card base to the 5½" x 4¼" piece of Fresh Freesia.
- Adhere the Basic White piece with the dots on the front of the card.
- Place Stampin' Dimensionals on one end of the Basic Black die cut and then about 1" from the other end. Adhere over the folded triangle with the Designer Series Paper. I lined it up so the corners of the flat edge met the edge of the triangle. The Stampin' Dimensionals should not be near the triangle piece. This will hold the flap down while allowing the card to be opened.
- Adhere the stamped greeting over the Basic Black die cut with Stampin' Dimensionals.

- a. Note: This is two layers of Stampin' Dimensionals and may require extra postage. You can eliminate one layer of Stampin' Dimensionals.
