Notes:

Prepare

1. Score the Crushed Curry card stock at 1/2" and 4 3/4".
2. Adhere the Designer Series Paper to the center section.
3. Center the #5 Deckled Rectangle Die in the center section and cut.
4. You will have a scrap of Crushed Curry card stock. Score and crease. Punch a scallop oval, aligning the scallops on the ends with the crease.
5. Fold the card and use the Double Oval Punch to cut a thumb hole at the top edge.
6. Score the 4" x 5 1/4" Basic White card stock at 3/8" along each long side.

Stamp & Color

7. Stamp the avocado in the center of the Window Sheet with Stāzon® ink. Clean the stamp with the Stāzon® Cleaner.
8. Stamp the avocado in Black Memento ink so it's in the exact same position.
9. Stamp the sombrero in Black Memento ink on the small piece of Basic White card stock. Then mask the bottom with scrap paper and stamp the cactus so it's wearing the hat. Stamp the smiling face just below the hat. Also stamp the donkey pinata. Color and (fussy) cut out.
10. On the Basic White piece with the avocado, stamp the greeting in Azure Afternoon ink above the avocado. Then stamp some of the other party food scattered around greeting and avocado. Avoid stamping on the top 1/2". Don't bother stamping on the bottom inch.
11. Color with the Stampin' Blends.

Assemble

12. Align the avocados on the Window Sheet and white piece. Trim, if needed so they match. Adhere the folded oval to the top, using Stampin' Seal+ or Tear & Tape. Punch a hole and knot the ribbon through the hole.
13. The back of the card base is the large section without the 1/2" flap.
14. Place the Basic White piece that was scored and creased inside the back section so the folds are up.

15. Put a small line of glue on the very bottom edge of the white piece. Place the plain 3" x 5" white piece on top so the bottom edges are even.
16. Slide the Window Sheet assembly with the colored card stock going behind and the Window Sheet going in front of the blank 3" x 5" piece. Add adhesive to the $\frac{3}{8}$ " flaps and to the $\frac{1}{2}$ " flap. Close the card.
17. You should see just the plain white avocado in the center of the opening.
18. Place a Stampin' Dimensional in the bottom corners of the Window Sheet. Do not let the Stampin' Dimensionals touch the card stock frame. Place the cactus and the donkey pinata on the Stampin' Dimensionals. Slightly bend the top and bottom of each up and away from the Window Sheet so they don't run into the card frame.
19. When you pull up on the ribbon, the Window Sheet assemble should pull up, bringing with it the cactus and donkey and it will also expose the greeting.
20. You may want to write a brief note or sign the card. Note where there is a blank area below the plain avocado. Use a ruler to measure where you can write so it's out of the way. You will be writing on that plain Basic White piece that doesn't move. It will continue to show below when the cactus and donkey are raised up.

*If you are not using a stamp positioning tool, stamp first on both the Window Sheet and the Basic White card stock. Line them up so the image matches, then cut to 3" x 5".
