## Notes:

## **Prepare**

- Score the card stock at 4 ¼". Fold and crease for the card base.
- 2. Optional: I cut a piece of 6" x 6" cardboard (the thin smooth white cardboard from the Designer Series Paper works great!) Copy the triangle cut-out on the left side and snip. Mark the 3 ¾" x 5" rectangle in the middle. You can use paper clips and/or temporary sticky tape to hold in place.

## Stamp & Color

- 3. Stamp the greeting of your choice in Early Espresso ink near the upper right corner of the Very Vanilla layer.
- 4. Place the Very Vanilla piece under the #1 Abundant Beauty Decorative Mask.
- 5. Using a Blending Brush, brush Daffodil Delight ink onto the flower petals. Be very careful and gentle when going over the greeting. It's better to tap the brush over the lettering so it doesn't smear.
- 6. Use another Blending Brush to brush Pumpkin Pie ink just around the center of the petals. Remove the mask and wipe it with a damp cloth or wipe.
- 7. Next, use the #2 mask and the Garden Green ink to brush the leaves.
- 8. Optional: I also brushed the all-over leaf and acorn mask on the inside of the card with Garden Green ink. I just brushed lightly around the edges. You can also brush the flap of the envelope.
- Next, use the #3 mask to brush Copper Clay ink on the flower centers.
- 10. Finally, use the #4 mask to lightly brush Early Espresso ink to highlight the centers.
- 11. Optional: Brush the flower centers with Wink of Stella.
- 12. Optional: Add the glue from the Fine-Tip Glue Pen to add a shiny and slightly raised area over the flower centers. Be aware that this glue takes more than a minute or two to dry.

## **Assemble**

- 13. Adhere the  $3\frac{3}{4}$ " x 1" strip to the bottom of the Early Espresso layer.
- 14. Wrap the ribbons across both layers about ½" above the bottom of the Very Vanilla strip and adhere to the back.
- 15. Hold the 3¾" x 5" Very Vanilla piece over the card front with the top 1½" from the edges. Very lightly mark the top of the ribbon and very lightly draw a line on the uninked areas. Fussy-Cut around the bottom of the leaves and flowers only

below the line. I left the right and left edges with a little flap that can go under the ribbon. Erase the lines. Adhere this layer to the card front. Use Mini Glue Dots, if needed, especially on the leaf.
