Notes:

I used layout #21 from the catalog, page 22 and Pumpkin Pie and Night of Navy are complementary colors.

- Score the Night of Navy card stock at 4¼". Fold and crease for the card base.
- Cut one of the Basic Beige pieces with the leaf frame and the outside frame. You may want to tape these two dies together to make positioning easier.
- Stamp the two orange stamps and the greeting in Saddle Brown StāzOn® ink on the watercolor paper.
- Watercolor the oranges and leaves. You may also want to stamp the edge of the Basic Beige inside layer and the envelope.
 - With a spare block or a piece of Window Sheet, stamp a bit of the Pumpkin Pie and Garden Green inks to use as a palette. The inks should not be close to each other.
 - Squeeze a small puddle of water onto the palette and paint one of the oranges that are touching each other with clear water. Keep the water only on the single orange and within the line. The paper should look fairly wet, but there should not be a puddle. Pick up a bit of Pumpkin Pie ink and tap two -three edges of the orange. Also tape the stem area. The color should spread only where the paper is wet.
 - Move to another orange that is not touching the first one. Repeat the process on each orange. Hopefully the first orange will be dry enough so the ink doesn't spread too much when you paint the orange that's next to it.
 - Clean the brush or use a different one. Repeat the process painting the leaves with water and then the veins with the Garden Green ink.
 - Finally, with ink on your brush, paint the stems with just the tip of the brush.
- Cut the oranges with the coordinating dies.
- Use Wink of Stella to color the flowers and/or oranges.
- Cut the greeting into a banner with Snips, the trimmer, or a die you may have.
- Adhere the inside layer.
- Adhere the Basic Beige die cut to the card front. I used Multipurpose Liquid Glue.
- Adhere the single orange to the upper left corner of the card.

11. Adhere the larger die cut near the lower right corner of the card with Stampin' Dimensionals.
12. Tie a large bow with the Very Vanilla Baker's Twine. Adhere to the back of the greeting, then adhere that on the left bottom area of the card with Stampin' Dimensionals.
