Notes:

There are lots of fussy pieces on my sample card, but you do not need to use all of them. You could have fewer woven strips and just one or two other decorations. You don't even need to make the basket 3D. Just cut one basket and adhere it to the card Designer Series Paper.

Prepare

- Score the Shy Shamrock card stock at ¼". Fold and crease for the card base.
- Score the 3½" x 1" Basic Beige card stock at ¼", ½", and ¾". Fold Mountain, Valley, Mountain and crease well with a Bone Folder. Cut off two 1" sections, leaving another 1½" section. You may want to add Tear & Tape to the long edges before cutting.
- Stamp the small bunny with the big ears in Pecan Pie ink on the Pecan Pie card stock.
- Stamp *Easter's on its way* in Shy Shamrock ink on one side of the 4¼" x 2¾" Basic White card stock. Punch out with the Modern Oval Punch. Punch a ⅛" hole in the upper left section. Stamp two of the three-flowers on the scrap.
- Stamp Happy Easter in Shy Shamrock ink on the top of the 5¼" x 4" Basic White card stock. Stamp the three flowers four times in Shy Shamrock ink, equally spaced across the bottom. Stamp three tulips between the flower clusters. Color the flowers on both this piece and the scrap from step 4. with the Stampin' Blends.
- Cut one of the panel sections from the Easter Joy Specialty Designer Series Paper to 4" x 5¼" adhere to the card front.
- Cut two baskets from the Designer Series Paper with the beige weave. You may want to cut some eggs from the reverse side of the Designer Series Paper. There is a die for this, but I think it might be just as easy to fussy cut the.
- Die cut decorations with the coordinating dies.
 - Two three-flowers from the Basic White scrap
 - Bunny from Pecan Pie card stock.
 - One carrot, two flower stems, the grass strip, and the strips (or at least one of the strips) from the Shy Shamrock card stock.
 - A flower, carrot, and a strip from the Peach Pie card stock.
 - A flower and a strip from the Lemon Lolly card stock.
 - A strip from the Petal Pink card stock
 - A strip from the Balmy Blue card stock
- Adhere the folded Basic Beige pieces to the beige printed side of one basket. The 1" pieces will be on the sides of the basket and the 1½" piece will be on the bottom. The long edges should be toward the center of the basket and the first fold should be toward the outside edge of the basket.

10. Weave the colors strips through the slits in the remaining basket. A suggestion: Straighten a large paper clip to use as a weaving shuttle.
 - a. Weave 5 strips: This is a tight fit and the last strip may be difficult. Weave the paper clip over and above the slits in the basket. Insert a strip above and below the paper clip. Remove the paper clip. Push the top strip up and the bottom strip down. Weave the paper clip through the opposite slits and between the two strips. Weave two more strips and push away from the center. Remove the paper clip. Weave the opposite (like the first strips) through the slits. Gently help the fifth strip through the center.
 - b. Weave 4 strips: These are not as tight and will be easier to work with. Weave the paper clip over and above the slits in the basket. Insert a strip above and below the paper clip. Remove the paper clip. Push the top strip up all the way and the bottom strip down.
 - c. Weave the paper clip through the opposite slits and between the two strips. Weave one strip next to the paper clip. Remove the paper clip. Push all three strips up. Weave the paper clip opposite the bottom strip. Gently help the fourth strip under the third strip.
11. Adhere the basket with the weaving to the other side of the folded Basic Beige card stock.
12. Using a lark's head knot, lace the Linen Thread through the hole in the tag.
13. Tie the ribbon around the handle of the basket. I just tied a knot, placing on of the Linen Thread ends under the knot.
14. Arrange the basket and as many of the die-cut pieces as you would like. I glued some under the front of the basket, some at the back of the basket, and some in empty places around the basket. Where you place them will depend on which printed panel you are using.
 - a. I did adhere a Peach Pie flower center to a Lemon Lolly flower and vice versa.
 - b. I cut the top of the Peach Pie carrot and glued it to the Shy Shamrock carrot top.
 - c. I glued the grass strip to the bottom of the basket.
