

I love the CraftSpace app! It does virtually everything we've done in Evernote, but it is a bit different. As I've whined about for several years, Evernote has changed both in features that we've used and in price. Last January I decided I was done with Evernote. I did vow to maintain my Evernote notes until January 2027.

I have tried a number of alternatives and in my opinion, they all lacked essentials. I didn't find anything lacking in the CraftSpace App. And that was before they've added even more features. They have been very responsive to requests for various features and they have ideas they plan to add in the future. Some of those future ideas will work best when more people are sharing the app, for instance moving some of the products we're ready to let go to a folder to buy and sell with other participants.

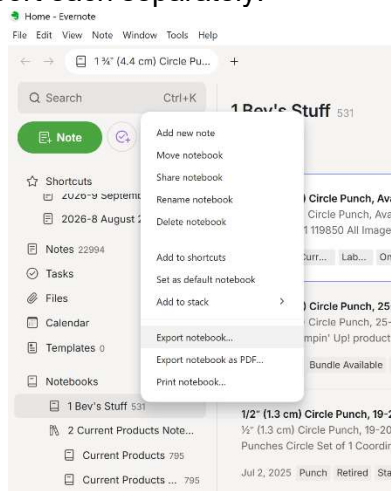
I'm still in love with the CraftSpace App! They are about to release it as an Apple app in a few days. And the app for Android will be released about mid August. I can't wait to see what that's like!

Now that about half the year has passed, people are approaching their Evernote subscription renewal. They are realizing they are being forced to make a decision. Here are the alternatives that I see.

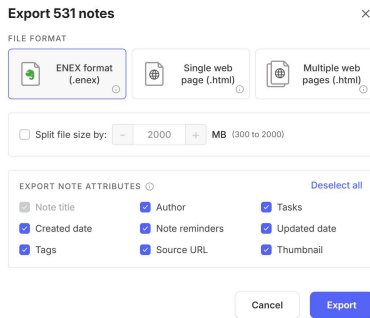
1. Move to the CraftSpace app.
2. Keep paying Evernote.
3. Try those alternatives and see if you like anything more appealing than I did.

I would like to recommend preparing to leave Evernote with these steps.

1. Export your notebook. You cannot do this from the online version! You need to use the app version on your computer.
2. I think it might be best to export your notes as both enex format and also in pdf format.
 - a. I shared a video on how to do it. <https://youtu.be/Y8WWtYJw0uY>
 - b. The enex format is what you will want to import to the CraftSpace app or perhaps other alternative that allow for import.
 - c. The pdf format allows you to look through your notes without any app. You will probably want to sort your notes in alphabetical order so you can find what you're looking for.
3. You will want to export only your notebook(s), not the shared Current Products, Retired Products, or Paper Pumpkin to Share notebooks. If you have more than one notebook, export each separately.



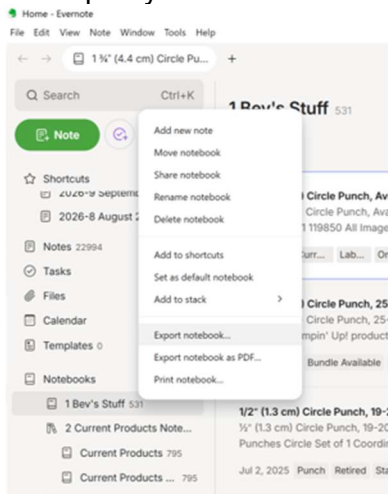
a. Right-click on your notebook.



b. First, select Export notebook.

c. Then select ENEX.

d. Then click Export. Save it somewhere that will be easy to find! You're ready to import your notes into the CraftSpace App!



Notice that Export notebook as PDF is right under the Export notebook option.

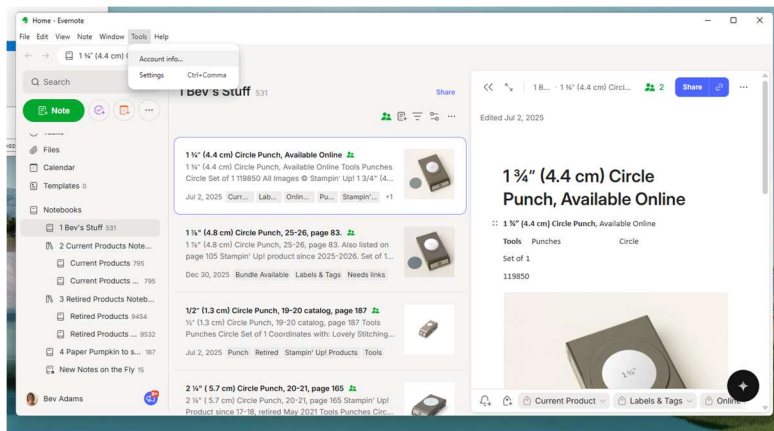
e. Click Export notebook as PDF

- i. Destinations: Save as PDF (There are other options.)
- ii. Pages: All
- iii. Orientation: Portrait
- iv. More Settings
- v. Paper size: US letter (or what makes sense to you. A2?)
- vi. Margins: Default (or maybe narrow?)
- vii. Color: Color
- viii. Page numbers: On
- ix. Note order: Leave in the order you had them, or maybe manually put in Stamps, Dies, etc.
- x. Note separation: Start each note on new page

f. Then click Export. You can look through your notes on your computer for reference in case something gets lost when you move your ENEX files.

You don't have to copy my notebook because it's already in the CraftSpace App.

Be sure to cancel your Evernote **before** your renewal date or you'll be stuck until the next renewal date.



To **change to monthly** billing: Perhaps you're not quite ready to cut the cord, but you don't want to pay for another full year. Go to Tools, Account Info, Billing, Billing Period, Change, and though I don't see Monthly, I assume you can type that in. I'm not ready to try it at this time.
To **delete your account**: Go to Tools, Account Info, Profile, look to the bottom of that page to find Account status, Click Close your Evernote account.

Be sure to use my link to get CraftSpace. I believe you'll start out at the free level, but you will need to get a paid level to import your notes. If you use my link you will get the Ultimate Level for the price of the Standard Level.
